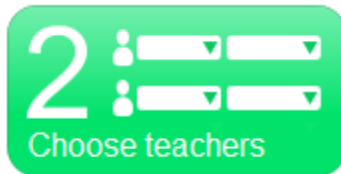

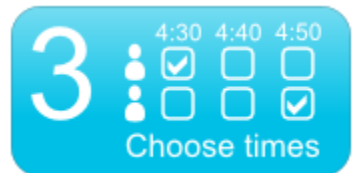

2012 Queensland Core Skills (QCS) Test:

Nomination of chief community representatives and community representatives

**Purpose**

To provide information to chief supervisors about the procedures to follow when nominating members of the community to be *Chief Community Representatives* or *Community Representatives* for the GCS Test.

**Background**

To maintain the accountability, security and correct conduct of the QCS Test at test centres, the Queensland Studies Authority (QSA) appoints members of the community to carry out duties on behalf of the QSA.

We invite members of the Mueller College community to apply for the positions of *Chief Community Representative*.

On behalf of the QSA the chief supervisor of each test centre receives completed application forms from interested members of the community and selects the appropriate person to nominate for each available position at the test centre.

The Mueller QCS centre needs three *Chief Community Representatives*.

**Nominations for chief community representative positions**

**Two nominations** (referred to as A and B) are required from each school for the Chief Community Representative positions. A third nomination (referred to as C) is recommended to fill the reserve position.

**What you need to do**

- An application to be a Chief Community Representative can be obtained from Mr Jacob.
- The *Declarations of Undertaking* from interested members of the community need to be in by Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> May.

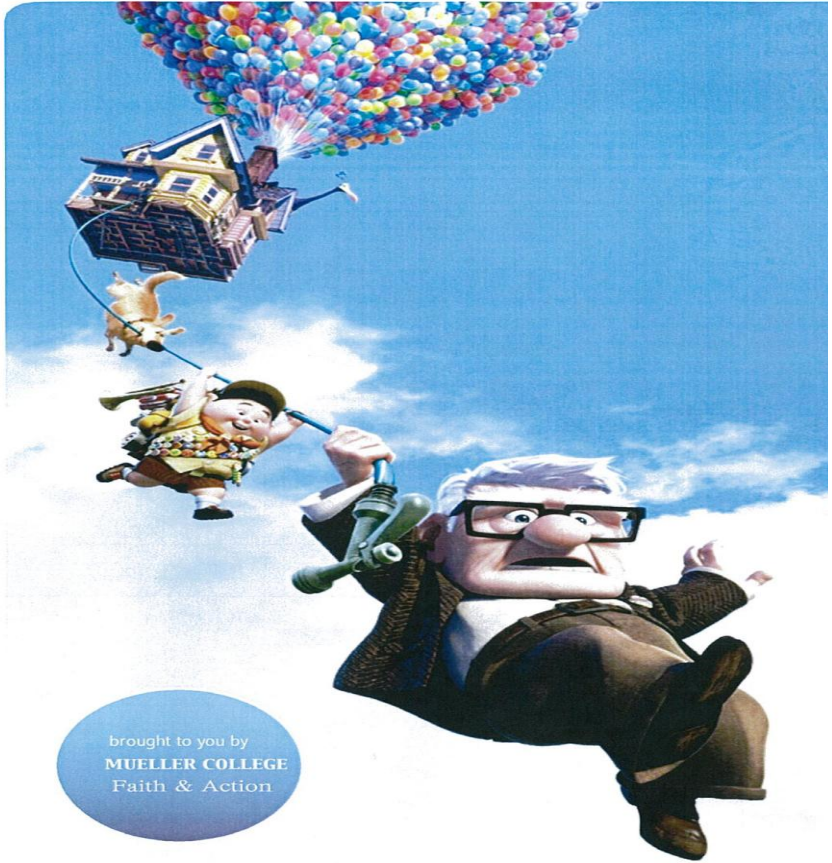

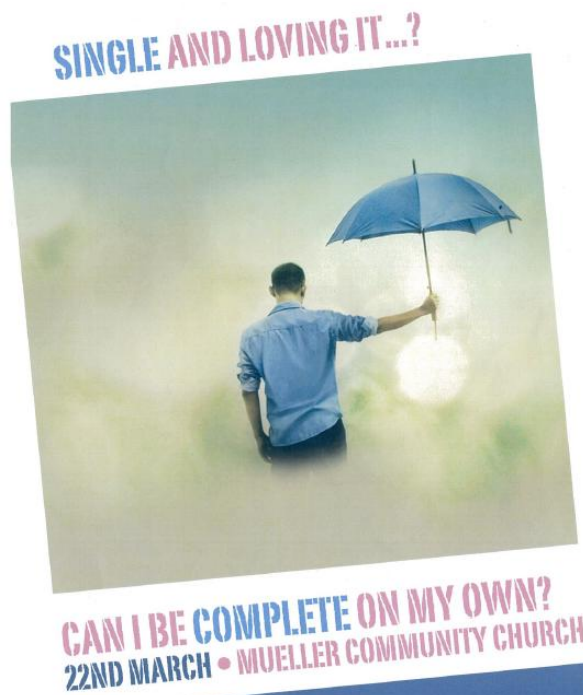

*TAX FILE NUMBERS-STUDENTS 13 YEARS AND OVER*



The Australian Taxation Office (ATO), with the cooperation of schools, offers students aged 13 years or over the opportunity to apply for a tax file number (TFN) through school. This is a voluntary program and makes it easier for students to obtain a TFN.

Students need a TFN for employment, applying for Centrelink benefits, opening a bank account or deferring university fees.

The form requires information such as the student's name, address and date of birth.

Students also need to provide the following details:

- Students **born in Australia** will need to provide their
  - birth certificate number, state of issue and year of registration, or
  - Australian passport number and date of issue.
- Students **born overseas** will need to provide their
  - overseas passport number and country of issue, or
  - Australian citizenship certificate number and date of issue, or
  - Australian passport number and date of issue.

It is important that the application form is fully completed and signed by the student. All information provided on the form will remain confidential.

Application forms are available from Front Office or Mr Jacob.

Application forms will be submitted to the ATO on 16<sup>th</sup> March 2012.

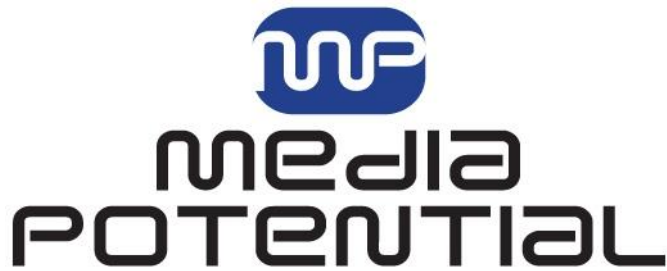
